

ORDINANCE NO. 623

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN, MINNESOTA
AMENDING AUSTIN CITY CODE CHAPTER 6.59, SUBD. 2,
BY REVISING SUBPARAGRAPH I. AND ADDING A NEW
SUBPARAGRAPH J. FOR THE PURPOSE OF FURTHER
REGULATING SIDEWALK CAFES**

The City Council of the City of Austin ordains:

Section 1. Austin City Code Chapter 6, Subd. 2.I., is hereby repealed in its entirety and a new Section 6.59, Subd. 2.I. is hereby enacted in lieu of thereof and shall read as follows:

I. No sidewalk café permit shall be issued to any establishment that does not meet or exceed one or more of the following:

- (i) possesses food service equipment that includes a range, oven, steam table, salad bar, or salad preparation area;
- (ii) possesses food service equipment that includes more than one deep fat fryer, one grill, or two hot holding containers; or
- (iii) is an establishment where food is prepared at one location and served at one or more separate locations.

Section 2. A new Austin City Code Chapter 6, Subd. 6.59, Subd. 2.J. is hereby enacted and shall read as follows:

J. No food or alcoholic beverages are allowed to be consumed or sold for consumption on the permitted area between the hours of midnight and 8:00 a.m. of any day.


