Members are appointed by the Mayor with the consent of the City Council at the first meeting in December of each year. You must be a resident of the City of Austin to serve on any of the following boards.

Cable TV Committee oversees franchise agreements for cable TV as well as the government access channel. A term on the board is three years. The board does not meet on a regular basis.

The **Charter Commission** consists of nine members. The commission is charged with reviewing and revising the City Charter, which acts as the city's constitution. A term on the Charter Commission is four years. The commission meets for special meetings as called.

The **City Planning Commission** consists of nine members who should be qualified by knowledge or experience to act in matters pertaining to the development of a city zoning plan. A term on the Planning Commission is four years. Meets second (occasionally third) Tuesday of every month at 5:30 pm and for special meetings as called.

The **Fire Civil Service Commission** consists of three members. The commission has supervision over the employment, promotion, discharge and suspension of all officers and employees of the Fire Department. A term on the commission is three years. The board normally meets for special meetings as called.

The **Housing and Redevelopment Authority Commission** consists of five members – one city representative, one HRA tenant, and three non-elected citizens. The purpose of the board is to provide decent, safe and sanitary housing to low income individuals and to facilitate economic development and redevelopment efforts. A term on the commission is five years. Meets third Wednesday of every month at 4:30 pm.

The **Human Rights Commission** consists of nine members whose purpose is to act informally to eliminate unfair discriminatory practices that are contrary to the public policies of the State of Minnesota. A term on the Human Rights Commission is three years. Meets fourth Tuesday of each month at 6:00 pm and for special meetings as called.

The **Library Board** consists of nine members whose purpose is to oversee the functions of the public library of the City of Austin. One seat is traditionally held by a council member. A term on the board is three years. All members must be qualified voters of the city. Meets second Monday of each month at 4:00 pm and for special meetings and committee meetings as called.

The **Park and Recreation Board** consists of seven members – one School Board District 492 representative and five citizens. One seat is traditionally held by a council member. The board's purpose is to oversee the public parks and recreation activities of the City of Austin. A term on the board is four years. Meets first Wednesday of each month at 5:15 pm and for special meetings as called.

The **Police Civil Service Commission** consists of three members. The commission has supervision over the employment, promotion, discharge and suspension of all officers and employees of the Police Department. A term on the commission is three years. The board meets for special meetings as called.

The **Austin Port Authority** consists of seven members – five citizens and two council members. The board carries out economic and industrial development and redevelopment within the city. A term on the board is six years. The board meets quarterly on the fourth Wednesday at 4:30 pm and for special meetings as called.

The **Austin Sustainability Taskforce** consists of up to 15 members whose purpose is to advise the City on sustainability issues and to facilitate GreenStep Cities Best Practices implementation. A term on the board is three years. Meets fourth Thursday of each month at 7:30 am.
