### **Public information meeting rescheduled to July 21 for the Interstate 90 and 4<sup>th</sup> Street Interchange project in Austin**

**AUSTIN, Minn.** – The Minnesota Department of Transportation has rescheduled the public information meeting for the I-90 and 4th Street Interchange project in Austin from Wednesday, July 14 to Wednesday, July 21 due to the possibility for severe weather.

MnDOT invites the public to attend a public meeting on Wednesday, July 21 to hear updates, learn about conceptual design options and provide input for the I-90 and 4th Street Interchange project.

#### **Background**

- The 4<sup>th</sup> Street bridge will be replaced, and the interchange reconstructed to improve operations, safety, and pedestrian and bicycle movements
- MnDOT has developed three design options for the interchange, each with unique characteristics
- MnDOT is requesting input from the public on important factors to include in the interchange design
- Construction is expected to begin in the spring of 2023
- The project also includes replacement of the I-90 Cedar River Bridges
