Deadlines

Friday June 31, 2020 is the last day managers may make changes to their NSF-MSF roster. ASA rosters are done online at <http://www.gosoftball.com> to fill out your ASA roster. NSF-MSF, ASA, & Park and Rec roster's are to be turned into our office by this date.

Reminders

- * Games will be 60 minutes, after 60 minutes of play the game will be played with the international rule where the last batter from the previous inning will start on 2nd base and the inning will start with 2 outs.
- * Field conditions must be extremely poor for us to cancel games before 5PM. In most cases, games that are cancelled because of inclement weather are cancelled by the umpires at the fields. If we cancel before 5PM you will receive a mass text, email, and check our Facebook page.
- * Teams will flip a coin to determine who is home/visitor.
- * Each team will provide a new or playable 12" .52 COR/.300 compression ball each game. Optic Yellow softballs are required.
- * Teams will hit their own softballs. Softballs that are hit out of play should be put back into play before the next batter.
- * Courtesy runners can be anyone on the roster. Only 1 per inning
- * No courtesy foul.
- * MSF pitching rules apply. Pitchers may stand up to 6' behind the rubber. Pitching Arc will be 6'-10'. 3-2 count. No Courtesy fouls
- League Pick-Up Players: you may pick up a max of 2 players from another team. This player must be paid for and rostered before you pick him up.
- * Home Run Limit is 3, any homeruns after your limit is an out.

- * Any bats that rattle or have a flat spot are illegal.
- * NO smoking or consumption of alcoholic beverages in, near or adjacent to the designated team areas.
- * NO consumption of alcoholic beverages during the game. Inebriated players will not be allowed to participate.
- NO TOBACCO, DOGS, OR PETS IN TODD PARK OR COMPLEXES! NO GLASS IN CITY PARKS!

INFECTIOUS DISEASE CONTROL RULE A player, coach or official who is bleeding or who has blood on their uniform shall be prohibited from participating until appropriate treatment has been administered.

CASUAL PROFANITY RULE/FAMILY ATMOSPHERE RULE Pertains to expletives not directed at umpires or opposing players, but uttered by a player/manager/coach frustrated with themselves, a teammate or fan. Penalty - If the offending team is at bat and profanity is used, the player is out unless the result of the play is an out in which case the next batter will be declared out. If the offending team is in the field the first player(s) to bat in their half of the inning will be declared out. It is possible for a team to come to bat with one or more outs already recorded or lose their bat altogether.
