- 1. Adopt/Approve Agenda Commissioner Berthiaume motioned to adopt and approve the reading of the agenda. Commissioner Garate seconded to adopt and approve the reading of the agenda. Motion passed unanimously.
- 2. Approve Meeting Minutes Commissioner Garate motioned to adopt, with corrections noted, and approve the reading of the minutes. Commissioner Hartman seconded to adopt and approve the reading of the minutes from January 23, 2023. Motion passed unanimously.

 Ritz seconded. Motion passed unanimously. It was noted that the Austin City
 Council approved \$1000 towards this project as well.
- 5. Update of event from yesterday at the YMCA Conversation with Law Enforcement:
 - Immigrant Law Center Sara Karki, Sheriff Sandvik and Chief McKichan all presented. Talked about navigating encounters and Q and A.
 - Attendance of about 60+ a large presence from Benin, Togo, and Mexico at the event. Interpreters for French, Spanish, Karen, Karenni were available. Childcare was available as well.
 - We need a better way to communicate what is going on for events besides Facebook.

- 6. Social Justice Book Club:
 - Commissioner Le will be leading the discussion in March and June.
 - Commissioner Spyhalski will also be leading a discussion on Dancing in the Darkness.
- 7. Portuguese Delegation in Austin March 22 and March 23
 - Part of Welcoming America and want to visit 5 cities in United States, learn from us that we have done and take things back to utilize in their communities.
 - Dinner March 22nd March 23rd tour the city and meet representatives from different local organizations. The Welcoming America report will be presented by Councilman Baskin. It was noted that the commission would like to work on updating the welcoming report.
